Mission

The Site Logistics Coordinator ensures the smooth flow of materials, equipment, and supplies throughout the construction of the Nsoko solar plant. This role is critical to keeping the project on schedule by preventing stock-outs, minimizing delays at border crossings (South Africa–Eswatini), and maintaining accurate inventory records on site.

Reporting to the Logistics Manager / Site Manager, the Site Logistics Coordinator will:

- Schedule and track all site deliveries, liaise with local and international suppliers in coordination with the Logistics Manager, and manage import documentation and customs clearance via border posts
- Receive, inspect, and store materials, maintain real-time inventory logs (Excel), and conduct regular stock counts, flagging shortages before they impact work fronts
- Organize internal site logistics (forklifts, flatbeds), coordinate third-party haulage, and ensure compliance with Eswatini road-transport regulations
- Provide weekly logistics reports to site management, and interface with subcontractors, freight forwarders, and the Eswatini Revenue Authority (SRA) for VAT and duty matters

Profil

- Fluent English is essential; siSwati is an asset for liaising with local suppliers and authorities
- Diploma or bachelor's degree in Logistics, Supply Chain Management, Business Administration, or a related field, with 3+ years of experience in construction-site logistics; renewable energy or infrastructure project experience is preferred
- Valid driver's license required; knowledge of SACU customs procedures is a plus

To succeed in this role, proficiency in MS Excel and inventory management software is essential for accurate inventory tracking and reporting, along with the ability to work effectively in a remote site environment.
